

Monday, May 25th



✚ Read Acts 16: 31 either aloud to your child, or have your child read it aloud to you.

✚ Watch the following video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=5t_3BuseTS0

✚ Ask the following questions:

- In the Bible story, Paul and Silas were faithful believers of Jesus, which is why they were arrested! Why do you think Paul and Silas continued to believe in Jesus even when they were in jail?
- What does the story of Paul and Silas teach you about the power of believing in Jesus?

✚ Close your conversation in prayer with your child.

Tuesday, May 26th



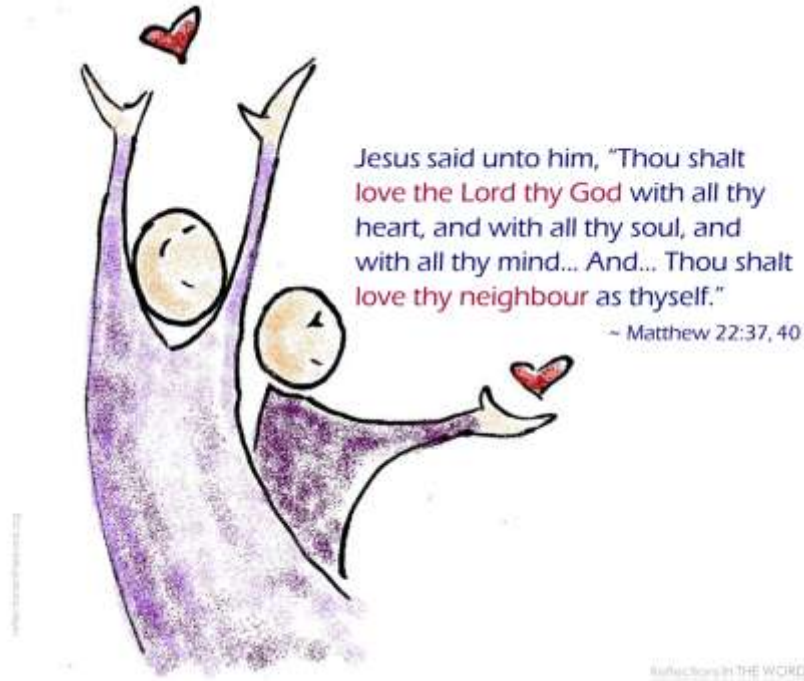
- ✚ Read Psalm 145 either aloud to your child, or have your child read it aloud to you.
- ✚ Ask your child what truths they learned about who God is from this Psalm.
- ✚ Close your conversation in prayer with your child.

Wednesday, May 27th



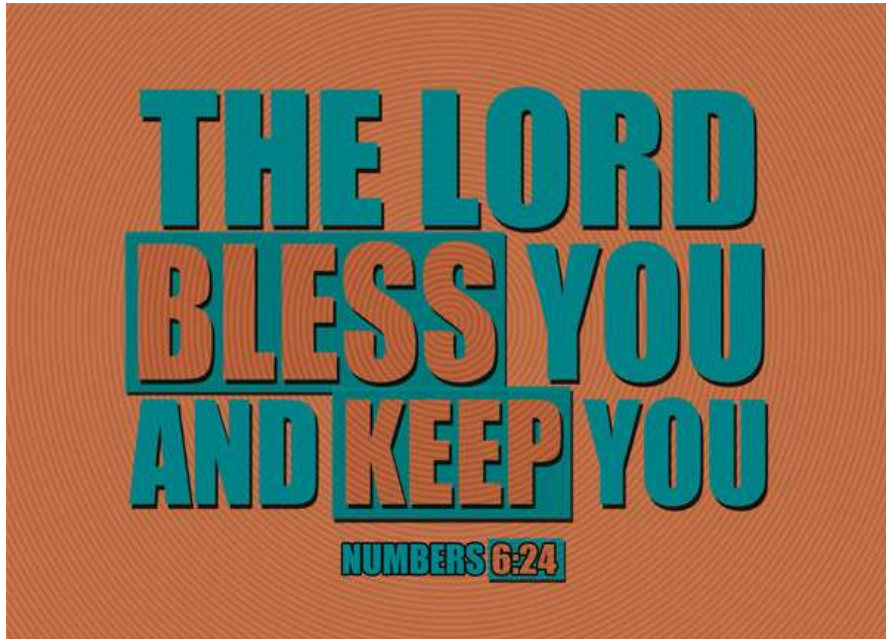
- ✚ Read Philippians 4: 4-9 either aloud to your child, or have your child read it aloud to you.
- ✚ Ask your child the following questions:
 - What does the Bible tell us to do when we are worried?
 - What does the Bible say will happen after giving our worries to God through prayer?
 - Think of a time when you have felt God's peace. What was happening? Who was with you? Describe how you felt.
- ✚ Close your conversation in prayer with your child.

Thursday, May 28th



- ✚ Read Matthew 22: 36-40 either aloud to your child, or have your child read it aloud to you.
- ✚ Watch the following video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hsGYVOUvUmE>.
As the video plays, pause the video each time a new question is asked & discuss the question with your child. Then, continue playing the video to hear what other children have to say.
- ✚ Close your conversation in prayer with your child.

Friday, May 29th



- ✚ Read Numbers 6: 22-27 either aloud to your child, or have your child read it aloud to you.
- ✚ God has promised to bless those who believe in Him, to be gracious to those who believe in Him, and to give peace to those who believe in Him. Ask your child to describe some of the ways in which God has blessed them, been gracious to them, and given them peace.
- ✚ Close your conversation in prayer with your child.

Saturday, May 30th



- ✚ Read Colossians 3: 1-2 and Colossians 3: 12-17 either aloud to your child, or have your child read it aloud to you.
- ✚ Ask the following questions:
 - What does it mean to, “set our minds on things that are above” and “not on things that are on Earth”? Why do you think God wants us to do this?
 - What do we look like when we clothe ourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, patience, and love?
- ✚ Close your conversation in prayer with your child.
