This scholarship is for the 2020-21 school year for students who will be attending full-time (minimum 12 units each semester, or 24 units for the year) at a community college, 4-year undergraduate college/university, or post graduate program.

GUIDELINES:

1. Scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement, church involvement, community service, and financial need. The following documents must accompany this application:
 - a. Proof of enrollment in the 2019-20 academic year
 - b. High School transcripts or college grades, whichever applies (GPA of 2.0 or higher)
 - c. Completed essay and budget worksheet described on back of this form.
 - d. A current photograph of yourself.
2. Students applying for the Wesley Scholarship must be enrolled and attend full-time (minimum of 12 units each semester, or 24 units for the year). Students going to community college or 4-Year undergraduate colleges/universities are eligible to apply. **SCHOLARSHIP CHECKS ARE ONLY AWARDED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE FALL SEMESTER.** If you don't meet the eligibility requirements until the following Spring semester, you will not be able to apply at that time.
3. Students reapplying for the Wesley Scholarship must have earned a grade point average of 2.0 in at least 24 units the previous year. Any summer school units from the previous summer will count toward the 24 units. Failure to complete the 24 units will require the repayment to the church, or result in ineligibility for future Wesley Scholarship consideration.
4. Students must be directly affiliated with First United Methodist Church of Chula Vista. This affiliation includes active membership by themselves or their parents/legal guardians; staff and their children; or others who currently play a substantial role in the life of the church. Members who are no longer active in the church will not be eligible. Relatives outside the immediate family of members or staff will not be eligible.
5. If selected for scholarship, the student will receive a check made out to the college or university. It will be the student's responsibility to submit the check to the school. **NO SCHOLARSHIP CHECKS WILL BE RELEASED UNTIL PROOF OF ENROLLMENT FOR THE FALL SEMESTER HAS BEEN PROVIDED.**
