

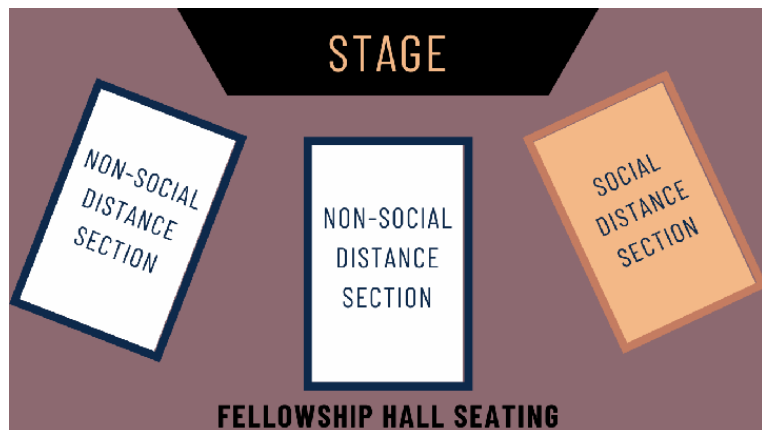
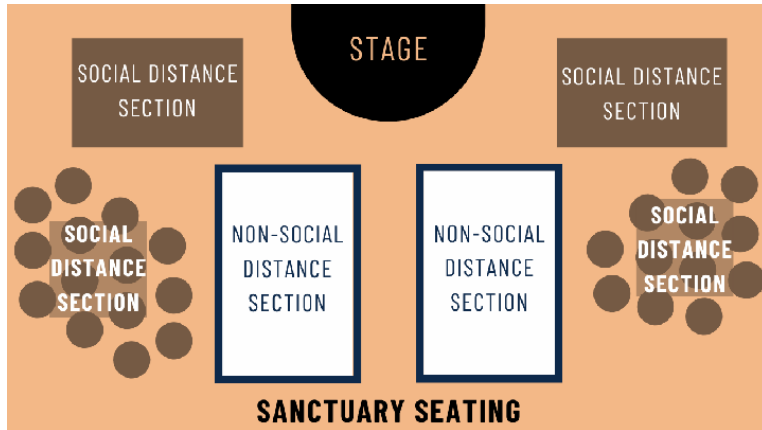
Food for Thought
