## Single Service

The first Sunday of October, (10/2) is our annual World Communion Sunday Single Service. We will gather both worship services at 10:00 am in the Sanctuary. These services are a wonderful way to meet folks who regularly attend another service than you, to enjoy the best of the music styles from the other service and to be together as a spiritual community. World Communion Sunday was begun in the 1930's, in between the two World Wars. There was recognition that Christian Churches were divided by politics, borders, conflicts and all the other representations of human strife. The first Sunday of October was set as a day that Christian Churches, the world around, would celebrate Holy Communion as a witness that our faith draws us together and that with Christ we shall not be divided. The meaning may not be as significant today, or it may have given the still divisive nature of our world, regardless; for us at FUMCCV it will be a day to be together in worship and then to enjoy some extended fellowship on the quad.

## United Women in Faith

Each year the FUMCCV unit of United Women in Faith (formerly known as United Methodist Women or UMW) has celebrated the service of individual members of the congregation within the ministries of the church, or within local, regional, national, or global missions – both those sponsored by the United Methodist Church and those to which Christ has called them – by presenting these disciples with Special Mission Recognition.
